Introduction to Taizé

The Taizé prayer service puts an emphasis on the value of silence. In Taizé, France, the bells ring three times a day to call everyone to pause and gather at the church for prayer. In the middle of each common prayer there is a long period of silence, a unique moment for meeting with God. The songs are of a repetitive style. According to the founder, Brother Roger, it is in the repeating that the Spirit will well up inside us; the music embracing us into God's presence; the simplicity of melodies connecting with our innermost selves.
